MINUTES OF MIDDLE BUCKS AREA VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL SCHOOL AUTHORITY MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 14, 2021

A duly advertised meeting of the Middle Bucks Area Vocational Technical School Authority was called to order at 5:30 o'clock P.M. on Tuesday, September 14, 2021, by Chairman Barry L. Pflueger, Jr. In addition to Mr. Pflueger, the following persons were present at the meeting: Authority Members Charles Kleinschmidt and the Honorable Bernie O'Neill. Also present at the Authority meeting were Kathryn Strouse, Administrative Director, Frank Ayata, Business Manager, Richard Hansen, Facilities Manager, and Donna J. Wengiel, Solicitor.

After discussion, and upon motion made, seconded, and carried, all Members voting aye, the Minutes of the June 21, 2021, meeting were approved as presented.

Frank Ayata reviewed the cash activity of the Authority for the period of June 1, 2021 to July 31, 2021.

Copies of the bills submitted to the Authority for payment were circulated to the Authority Members for review prior to the meeting. The bills presented constituted bills to be paid from the U.S. Bank Bond Administration Expense Fund, Series 2015 and 2020. Upon motion made, seconded, and carried, all Members voting aye, the bills were approved for payment. A true and correct copy of the list of the bills being authorized to be paid is attached hereto, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A".

Richard Hansen reviewed the Summary of Responses received with regard to the replacement of roof sections J and M, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "B". Administration advised the Authority Members that while Patriot Roofing, Inc. and Jottan, Inc. submitted the lowest bids, they failed to conform with the bid specifications and, in particular, failed to meet the time frame outlined in the bid specifications for completion of the project. Munn Roofing, Inc. was the next lowest bid at a base bid of \$374,000.00, a bid of \$17,400.00 for the skylight replacement and a bid of \$26,400.00 with curbs.

After discussion, upon motion made, seconded, and carried, all members voting aye, the Authority rejected the bids submitted by Patriot Roofing, Inc. and Jottan, Inc. on the basis that they were non-conforming and awarded the roof replacement contract for sections J and M of the roof to Munn Roofing, Inc. at a base bid price of \$374,000.00, with \$17,400.00 bid for skylight replacement and \$26,400.00 bid with curbs, in compliance with the Pennsylvania Municipality Authorities Act, subject to compliance by the successful bidder with all of the requirements set forth in the bidding instructions. Further resolved, that upon satisfaction by the successful bidder of all necessary requirements, the officers of the Authority are authorized and directed to execute and deliver to Munn Roofing, Inc. a construction agreement substantially in the form approved by the Authority and included in the bid specification package.

Richard Hansen provided the Authority Members with an update on the North Plaza project and presented to the Authority Members for review a plan prepared by the engineering group ELA Group, Inc.

Chairman Barry Pflueger requested the business manager to confirm the deadline for the expenditure of the remaining bond proceeds from the U.S. Bank 2020 Settlement Fund.

Kathryn Strouse presented the Authority Members with an update on the dispute with Paneko and Versico with regard to sections A, B and C of the roof. The redesign of those sections is currently in process and the work will go out to bid. Executive Council directed its solicitor to pursue litigation against Paneko and Versico for damages.

The date of the next Authority meeting will be set at a subsequent time and confirmed through Administration.

There being no further business to come before the Authority, the meeting was duly adjourned at 6:05 p.m.



This memo is written to explain our rationale for recommended the bid be awarded to Munn Roofing Inc.

While Munn Roofing Inc. was not the lowest bidder, they replaced Sections D & E in fall 2020 and did a quality job that was completed on schedule.

Munn Roofing Inc. is the only contractor that is able to beginning the job on October 1, 2021 with substantial completion by November 30, 2021 and 100% completion by December 31, 2021. The other contractors are not able to start the project until somewhere between April 1, 2022 and June 1, 2022.

The roof Sections J & M currently leak. There is a tarp system in the Engineering lab to collect water that leaks in after inclement weather.

It is for these reasons that we are recommending the bid is awarded to Munn Roofing Inc.



Based on our visual observation of the roof systems on the subject building roof areas A, B and C are in poor condition. There were no major defects noted on the EPDM membrane. However, ridging and buckling insulation were found throughout all roof areas. Numerous backing out fasteners were also documented along the perimeters and in the roofing field. Due to the amount of backing out fasteners and buckling insulation, it is assumed the fasteners were not properly secured to the steel deck. The drainage of the roofing systems is being impeded due to the severity of buckling and ridging insulation. With the amount of backing out fasteners documented throughout the roofing systems the roof areas may not meet the FM wind uplift requirements. It is recommended that roof areas A, B and C are replaced.

Core-cuts were taken on roof areas A, B and C. Roof Area A consists of a mechanically fastened EPDM membrane, 1.50" polyisocyanurate insulation, 0.50" gravel asphalt built-up roof, 0.75" wood fiber board, 6.00" polyisocyanurate insulation and a steel deck. Roof Areas B and C consists of a mechanically fastened EPDM membrane, 1.50" polyisocyanurate insulation, 1.00" gravel asphalt built-up roof, 1.00" wood fiber board, 1.50" polyisocyanurate insulation and a steel deck. No moisture was documented at any of the core-cut locations.

RoofConnect has been in contact with the Code Enforcement Officer at Warwick Township Bucks County. Warwick Township Bucks County has adapted the 2015 International Building Code. In section 1511.3.1.1 of the 2015 International Building Code it states "A roof recover shall not be permitted where any of the following conditions occur... 3. Where the existing roof has two or more applications of any type of roof covering." The Code Enforcement Officer stated they will approve a building code variance to the 2015 International Building Code Section 1511.3.1.1. This variance will allow the removal of the mechanically fastened EPDM roof system and the installation of a new roof system over the existing gravel asphalt built-up roof system on roof areas A, B and C. RoofConnect recommends a tear off down to the existing gravel asphalt built-up roof and having a new single-ply roofing system installed.






Overview of the East elevation. Picture #1
















View of target patch repair at core-cut near the North perimeter of Roof Area B. Picture #10










Overview of Roof Area C. Roof Area A consists of a mechanically fastened EPDM roofing system. Picture #1






